DEFAULT JUDGMENT AGAINST DEFENDANT
JAMES FARNHAM

This matter came on for hearing before this Court on this 13th day of July, 2009, on the motion of Plaintiff for default judgment against Defendant James Farnham (Farnham).

The Court, having reviewed all pleadings and evidence, finds that Farnham is in default for failure to answer or otherwise plead to the March 24, 2009 *Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief* (Petition), and the April 10, 2009 *First Amendment to Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief* (Amended Petition), and his time for doing so has expired. The Court, further finds that the Farnham is in default for failure to secure an entry of appearance by counsel and his time for doing so has expired. The Court, being fully advised in the premises, and on consideration thereof, finds that the allegations in Plaintiff's Petition and Amended Petition are deemed true as therein set forth with respect to Farnham and that Plaintiff is entitled to the relief prayed for and, therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a permanent injunction be and is hereby entered, forever enjoining and restraining Farnham from offering and/or selling securities in and/or from this state.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Farnham pay restitution to all investors who purchased securities in the nature of notes (Investment Notes) from Farnham or who transferred money to the Heritage Defendants for the purpose of purchasing the Investment Notes or otherwise making investments on their behalf, and that the amount and allocation of restitution to investors shall be determined by this Court at the conclusion of this case as to the Heritage Defendants.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Court will retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purpose of enforcement of this Order.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
