MOTION FOR DEFAULT JUDGMENT AGAINST DEFENDANTS
GLOBAL WEST FUNDING, LTD., CO., GLOBAL WEST FINANCIAL LLC, SURE
LOCK FINANCIAL, LLC, SURE LOCK LOANS LLC
AND THE WAVE-GOLDMADE LTD.

Plaintiff moves this Court to enter judgment by default in its favor and against Defendants Global West Funding, Ltd., Co., Global West Financial LLC, Sure Lock Financial, LLC, Sure Lock Loans LLC, and The Wave-Goldmade Ltd. (collectively, "Global West Defendants") for the relief prayed for in the *Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief*. In support of this motion, Plaintiff states as follows:

1. On March 24, 2009, a *Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief* (Petition) was filed against the Global West Defendants.
2. On March 24, 2009, a *Temporary Restraining Order, Order Freezing Assets and Order for Accounting* (Order) was issued by this Court against the Global West Defendants.
3. On March 25, 2009, Clell I. Cunningham III filed an *Order Modifying, In Part, Temporary Restraining Order, Order Freezing Assets and Order for Accounting* (Modified Order) on behalf of the Global West Defendants.

4. On April 1, 2009, an *Entry of Appearance* was filed by Richard L. Rose on behalf of the Global West Defendants.

5. On April 1, 2009, an *Agreed Order Appointing Special Master* (Special Master Order) was filed.

5. On April 10, 2009, Plaintiff filed the *First Amendment to Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief* (Amended Petition).

6. On April 24, 2009, Clell I. Cunningham III and Richard L. Rose filed an *Answer of Global West Defendants* on behalf of the Global West Defendants.

7. On May 22, 2009, an *Order Allowing Withdrawal of Richard L. Rose as counsel for Defendants* was entered by the Court. This order required the Global West Defendants to secure an entry of appearance by other counsel within thirty (30) days from the date of the order.

8. On May 26, 2009, an *Order Allowing Withdrawal of Clell I. Cunningham III as counsel for Global West Defendants* was entered by the Court. This order required the Global West Defendants to secure an entry of appearance by other counsel within ten (10) days from the date of the order.

9. The Global West Defendants have failed to secure an entry of appearance by other counsel and their time for doing so has expired pursuant to 12 O.S §2005.2(C).

WHEREFORE, premises considered, Plaintiff prays for the Court to grant the following relief:

I.

That judgment by default be entered in its favor and that the Global West Defendants be permanently enjoined from offering and/or selling securities in any capacity in and/or from this state; and

II.

That judgment by default be entered in its favor and against the Global West Defendants for restitution to all investors who purchased Investment Notes, as defined in the Petition, from the Global West Defendants or who transferred money to the Global West Defendants for the purpose of purchasing the Investment Notes, as defined in the Petition, or otherwise making investments on their behalf, on a pro rata basis, and that the amount and allocation of restitution to investors, shall be determined by this Court at the conclusion of this case; and

III.

That pending determination of the amount of restitution to be paid by the Global West Defendants, the assets of the Global West Defendants continue to be subject to the Modified Order and the Special Master Order.

DEFAULT JUDGMENT AGAINST DEFENDANTS
GLOBAL WEST FUNDING, LTD., CO., GLOBAL WEST FINANCIAL LLC,
SURE LOCK FINANCIAL, LLC, SURE LOCK LOANS LLC AND
THE WAVE-GOLDMADE LTD.

This matter came on for hearing before this Court, on the motion of Plaintiff for default judgment against Defendants Global West Funding, Ltd., Co., Global West Financial LLC, Sure Lock Financial, LLC, Sure Lock Loans LLC, and The Wave-Goldmade Ltd. (collectively, "Global West Defendants").

The Court, having reviewed all pleadings and evidence, finds that the Global West Defendants are in default for failure to secure an entry of appearance by counsel and their time for doing so has expired. The Court, being fully advised in the premises, and on consideration thereof, finds that the allegations of Plaintiff's *Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief* are deemed true as therein set forth with respect to the Global West Defendants, and that Plaintiff is entitled to the relief prayed for and, therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a permanent injunction be and is hereby entered, forever enjoining and restraining the Global West Defendants from offering and/or selling securities in and/or from this state.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Global West Defendants pay restitution to Investors who purchased Investment Notes, as defined in the Petition, or who transferred money to the Global West Defendants for the purpose of purchasing the Investment Notes, as defined in the Petition, or otherwise making investments on their behalf, on a pro rata basis, and that the amount and allocation of restitution to Investors, shall be determined by this Court at the conclusion of this case.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pending determination of the amount of restitution to be paid by the Global West Defendants, the assets of the Global West Defendants continue to be subject to the Modified Order and the Special Master Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Court will retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purpose of enforcement of this order.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
