

**ORDER**

On August 9, 2006, Respondents were properly served with the *Notice of Opportunity for Hearing* ("Notice") with the *Enforcement Division Recommendation* ("Recommendation") attached. The Notice stated that a request for a hearing on the Recommendation must be received by the Administrator within fifteen (15) days after service of the Notice or a final order may be issued as set forth in Section 1-411 of the Oklahoma Uniform Securities Act of 2004 ("Act"), Okla. Stat. tit. 71, §§ 1-101 through 1-701 (Supp. 2003). However, Section 660:2-9-1 of the Rules of the Oklahoma Securities Commission and the Administrator of the Department of Securities ("Rules") allows twenty (20) days in which a respondent may file a request for a hearing.

On August 22, 2006, counsel for the Department informed Respondents' legal counsel via telephone that Respondents had twenty days in which to request a hearing.

On August 29, 2006, the twentieth day after service of the Notice, Respondents' filed a *Motion to Quash and Objection to Jurisdiction by Respondents, and Pleading in the Alternative, Answer, and, Pleading in the Alternative, Request for Hearing* ("Answer"). The Answer contained a request for hearing and admissions and denials of the allegations contained in the Recommendation, as required.

Respondents were accorded the benefit of the longer period as set forth in the Rule.


**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondents' motion to quash and objection to jurisdiction is denied.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that pursuant to 660:2-9-2 of the Rules, a hearing shall commence at 9:00 a.m. on November 21, 2006, in the offices of the Oklahoma Department of Securities, First National Center, Suite 860, 120 North Robinson, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, to

afford Respondents the opportunity to show why an order based on the Recommendation should not be issued.
