**ORDER ALLOWING WITHDRAWAL AS COUNSEL
FOR RENAISSANCE U.S.A., INC. AND STAYING ACTION**

The cause is before the Court on the Application of Conner & Winters, P.C., by and through John W. Funk and Timothy J. Bomhoff, to withdraw from the representation of Defendant, Renaissance U.S.A., Inc. ("Renaissance"). Plaintiff has objected to said Application only as to staying this action. After hearing from counsel for both Renaissance and the Plaintiff, the Court finds that good cause has been shown and that the Application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Conner & Winters, P.C., by and through John W. Funk and Timothy J. Bomhoff, are hereby allowed to withdraw as attorneys of record for Defendant, Renaissance U.S.A., Inc. and the clerk of the Court is directed to strike their names as attorneys of record for Renaissance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Renaissance shall, within thirty (30) days of this Order, secure an entry of appearance by other counsel by filing a statement with the Court Clerk showing


an address where all further papers in this case may be served upon it, and serve such statement on counsel for the Plaintiff, at the following address:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all deadlines currently in effect relating to Renaissance U.S.A., Inc., are extended until July 6, 1998, and, specifically, the answer date for Renaissance U.S.A., Inc., shall be extended to July 17, 1998, and the hearing on the Plaintiff's Application for Preliminary Injunction shall be extended to July 24, 1998, at 9:00 a.m.


