SECOND ORDER MODIFYING ASSET FREEZE

Before the Court is the motion of the Defendant, Lynn Bradley ("Bradley"), to dissolve the temporary restraining order and order freezing Bradley's assets entered on April 17, 2003, and modified by this Court on May 2, 2003. The parties have agreed to modify this Court's April 17, 2003 Order ("Order Freezing Assets"), as amended on May 2, 2003. The parties agree to exclude from the Order Freezing Assets any income earned by Lynn Bradley after the date of this Order and any funds received by Bradley that are exempt from execution, attachment, garnishment or other process as provided by Okla. Stat. Ann. tit. 36, § 3631.1.A. Any funds directly or indirectly related to the activities and operations of B & B Worm Farm, B & B Worm

Farms, Inc., and/or any funds directly or indirectly received from the activities of Gregory Miles Bradley or directly or indirectly received from the estate of Gregory Miles Bradley (the "Excluded Funds") remain subject to the Order Freezing Assets, as modified on May 2, 2003. Bradley shall be permitted to open a depository account with a financial institution to hold funds earned as income by Bradley after the date of this Order and any funds received by Bradley that are exempt from execution, attachment, garnishment or other process as provided by Okla. Stat. tit. 36, § 3631.1.A.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Bradley shall be permitted to establish a depository account at a financial institution to hold funds earned as income by Bradley after the date of this Second Order Modifying Asset Freeze, except Excluded Funds, and any funds received by Bradley that are exempt from execution, attachment, garnishment or other process as provided by Okla. Stat. tit. 36, § 3631.1.A. Assets authorized by this Order to be deposited in this account shall not be subject to the Order Freezing Assets, as modified on May 2, 2003.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that any Excluded Funds received by Bradley shall be transmitted to Janice Loyd, the Chapter 7 Trustee appointed to liquidate the assets of B & B Worm Farms, Inc.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Order Freezing Assets, as amended on May 2, 2003, shall remain in effect except as modified herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that a hearing to review the order freezing the personal assets of Lynn Bradley is set for the 24th day of September, 2003, at 1:30 p.m. before the Honorable Noma Gurich.




