ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY RELIEF

This matter came on for hearing this 14 day of Feb, 2008, before the undersigned Judge of the District Court in and for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, on the application of Plaintiff for emergency relief to freeze the newly discovered assets of Defendant Phillip Levaughn Raglin (Raglin) and to require Raglin to terminate any investment related internet sites or advertising. Plaintiff appears by and through its attorney, Patricia A. Labarthe.

The Court, having reviewed all pleadings and submissions, finds that the application be, and hereby is, granted and, therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the assets of Phillip Levaughn Raglin, Mel Cooper, Melinda Cooper, Melinda Raglin, Divine Development LP, and the assets of any other entity or person over which Phillip Levaughn Raglin has control and/or access to assets, are hereby frozen. The asset freeze includes, but is not limited to, JP Morgan Chase Bank, NA Account Number [REDACTED] and any bank, depository institution, or other financial institution account using the following social security numbers: [REDACTED] and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the freeze shall include, but not be limited to, any funds located in any bank, depository institution, internet, securities, or other financial institution account in the name of Phillip Levaughn Raglin, Mel Cooper, Melinda Cooper, Melinda Raglin, Divine Development LP, and any other account that Phillip Levaughn Raglin, Mel Cooper, Melinda Cooper, Melinda Raglin, or Divine Development has control of and/or access to funds. It shall also apply to accounts in the name of any individuals or entities controlled by Phillip Levaughn Raglin, Mel Cooper, Melinda Cooper, Melinda Raglin, or Divine Development, or accounts over which Phillip Levaughn Raglin, Mel Cooper, Melinda Cooper, Melinda Raglin, or Divine Development have signatory or other designated authority. All banks, depository institutions, internet service providers, securities firms, or other institutions or persons served with a copy of this Order Granting Emergency Relief, shall cooperate with the Oklahoma Department of Securities relating to implementation of this Order Granting Emergency Relief, including imposing a freeze on all assets, including accounts and funds, and producing records relating thereto. Facsimile transmission shall constitute service on the banks, depository institutions, internet service providers, securities firms, or other institutions or persons.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Phillip Levaughn Raglin terminate any investment related internet sites or advertising, including but not limited to, that of Divine Development LP.
