**FINAL ORDER OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION AND  
FOR PAYMENT OF RESTITUTION**

This matter came on for hearing this 20<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2024, before the undersigned Judge of the District Court in and for Creek County, State of Oklahoma, upon the agreement of the Plaintiff Oklahoma Department of Securities (“Department”) and Defendant Robert N. Boone (“Boone”). The Court, having reviewed all of the evidence offered and the Court file, and being advised that the parties agree to the entry of this Order, finds as follows:

1. On September 15, 2023, the Department filed a *Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Relief* pursuant to the Oklahoma Uniform Securities Act of 2004 (“Act”), Okla. Stat. tit. 71, §§ 1-101 through 1-701 (2023), the allegations of which are hereby adopted and incorporated herein by reference.

2. On June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024, Boone executed the Stipulation and Consent of Robert N. Boone (“Stipulation and Consent”), a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and made a part hereof.

Therefore, based on the evidence reviewed, including the attached Stipulation and Consent, the Court finds that the following order should be entered.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Boone be and hereby is permanently enjoined from transacting business in and/or from the state of Oklahoma as an issuer, issuer agent, broker-dealer, broker-dealer agent, investment adviser, and/or investment adviser representative, and from otherwise offering and/or selling securities in and/or from the state of Oklahoma.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Boone pay restitution to Violet Estrello as follows: (1) an initial lump sum payment in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) to be made within thirty (30) days of signing the Stipulation and Consent, and (2) monthly payments to Violet Estrello in the amount of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) each, beginning sixty (60) days after signing this Stipulation and Consent and continuing monthly thereafter, on or before the 10<sup>th</sup> day of each month, until the death of Boone or Violet Estrello, whichever occurs first.



**STIPULATION AND CONSENT OF ROBERT N. BOONE**

Robert N. Boone (“Defendant”) hereby stipulates to the following:

1. The Administrator of the Oklahoma Department of Securities (“Plaintiff”) is the proper party to bring this action seeking the relief requested in the *Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Relief* (“Petition”) filed in this matter.
2. Defendant is subject to the jurisdiction of this Court and this Court has subject matter jurisdiction of this action.
3. Defendant offered and sold an unregistered security in violation of Section 1-301 of the Oklahoma Uniform Securities Act of 2004 (“Act”), Okla. Stat. tit. 71, §§ 1-101 through 1-701 (2023); and has acted as an unregistered agent in violation of Section 1-402 of the Act. Mr. Boone’s violations of the Act materially aided Steve Parish, Premier Global Corporation, and the PF Entities (as defined in the Petition) in violating Section 1-501 of the Act.
4. Defendant does not contest the application of the Oklahoma Uniform Securities Act of 2004 to the offer and/or sale of the security, namely a promissory note, as described in the Petition.



Defendant hereby undertakes as follows:

1. Defendant consents to the entry of the *Final Order of Permanent Injunction and For Payment of Restitution* ("Order"), in the form attached as Exhibit "A".

2. Defendant states that this *Stipulation and Consent of Robert N. Boone* ("Stipulation and Consent") is entered into voluntarily and that no threat or promise of immunity of any kind has been made by the Administrator of the Oklahoma Department of Securities, any member of the Oklahoma Securities Commission, or any employee of the Oklahoma Department of Securities to induce Defendant to enter into this Stipulation and Consent.

3. Defendant waives any right to appeal from the Order.

4. Defendant agrees that the provisions of this Stipulation and Consent shall be incorporated by reference into the Order as though set forth in full therein.

5. Defendant agrees that this Court will retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purpose of enforcement of the Order and this Stipulation and Consent.

6. Defendant agrees that he will not offer or sell securities in and/or from this state.

7. Defendant agrees to pay restitution to Violet Estrello as follows: (1) an initial lump sum payment in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) to be made within thirty (30) days of signing this Stipulation and Consent, and (2) monthly payments to Violet Estrello in the amount of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) each, beginning sixty (60) days after signing this Stipulation and Consent and continuing monthly thereafter, on or before the 10<sup>th</sup> day of each month, until the death of Defendant or Violet Estrello, whichever occurs first.

8. Defendant acknowledges that Plaintiff may take action as authorized by law for Defendant's failure to comply with the terms of the Order and this Stipulation and Consent in any material respect or for any future violation of the Act.

9. Defendant agrees to the presentation of this Stipulation and Consent and the Order to the Court to be entered without further notice to him.


